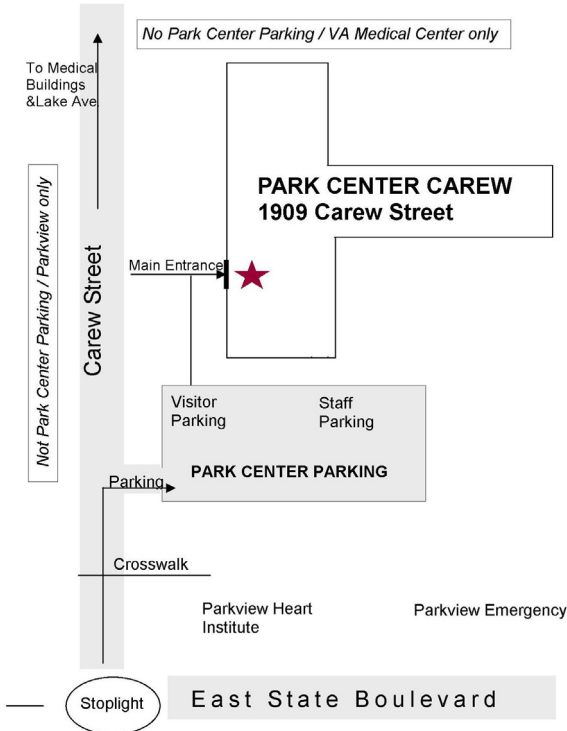

SUPPORT SERVICES

Park Center offers recovery services to those who are the most affected by serious mental illness.



Mental illness can profoundly disrupt a person’s thinking, feelings, moods, ability to relate to others, and capacity for coping with the demands of daily life. **Park Center’s Intensive Support Services** offers stabilization services that provide an array of supports that would enable consumers to not only achieve symptom control, but work toward their goals of living productive and satisfying lives.

The following services are available:

Adult Intensive Rehabilitation Services

- Adult Intensive Rehabilitation Services (AIRS) is a structured group program designed to provide short-term, intensive services to individuals in need of stabilization and supportive services to assist in the successful transition from acute hospital care to outpatient services, or for individuals already in outpatient care. Staff provide rapid linkage and coordinate the services a consumer might require to expedite their timely discharge from acute hospital care services.



Transitional Care Services

- With a capacity of 15 beds, Transitional Care Services (TCS) - a sub-acute service - is available to provide stabilization with short-term stays to consumers who do not need an acute hospital stay. After-hours and emergency services are also provided.

Assertive Community Treatment

- The Assertive Community Treat team (ACT) provides care coordination and activities of daily living (ADL) training/management services to consumers with the most intense needs to help reduce/avoid acute hospitalizations. This community-based team goal is to provide support for the consumer’s maximum recovery and enhance the individual’s quality of life.
