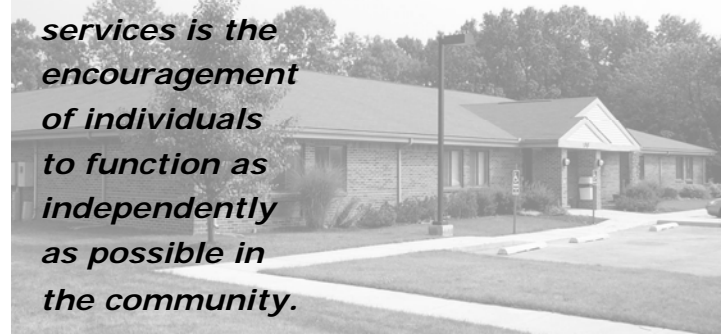

ADULT RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Park Center offers a range of housing opportunities that complement therapeutic needs. All residential services encourage self-help, the development of social skills, and problem-solving. Placements available include:

- **Group Homes -**
 - Haven House:** This co-ed residential treatment facility provides the highest degree of structure and staff supervision in a home-like environment. Because of the severity of the residents' psychiatric impairments and in some cases physical disabilities, nursing support is available 24 hours a day on-site.
 - Unity and Quinn House:** These residences offer a structured living arrangement, but are for those who are less psychiatrically impaired than those in residence at Haven House, and whose conditions have begun to stabilize.
- **Community Housing:** These apartment options offer the advantage of on-site staff support which enable residents who had previously experienced difficulty maintaining independence in their own apartments, to become nearly self-sufficient. The apartments are an extension of a program developed by HUD, whose goal was to provide affordable housing for those with chronic mental illness. These co-ed apartments are located in residential neighborhood settings, and offer complete apartment units.
- **Independent Living Apartments:** Transitional housing and case management services are offered to people who require residential assistance, but do not need the on-site support of Park Center staff, nor the structure of a group home setting. Many apartments are used throughout the community for this purpose. Case management services are provided to clients involved in this living option in order to ensure sufficient skills to live safely and productively in their own homes.
